

General Rules

1. The Garden Festivals Company, or any persons acting on its behalf, shall not be held responsible for any accident or injury to any person, animal or property, howsoever caused.
2. All riders, whether competing or not, must wear correctly fitting hard hats to the current recognised B.S. standard, at all times.
3. The judge's decision in all cases is final.
4. Dogs must be kept on leads at all times.
5. The secretary reserves the right to alter the schedule at any time without prior notice.
6. For First Aid costs £2 per competitor will be added to the entry fees.
7. No class will start before the stated time on the timetable, but classes may run late depending on entries.
8. Competitors must be correctly dressed, i.e. hat, jacket, collar and tie/stock, jodhpurs and riding boots, when competing.
9. It is the responsibility of all horse owners to ensure that their animals are fully vaccinated against equine flu and have horse passports.

10. In Equitation classes, Snaffle Bridles only must be worn.
11. Do not MUCK OUT Horse boxes or trailers onto the fields. Any person found leaving waste/manure on the grounds will be asked to leave with no re-imbusement
12. The showground is on school football fields please respect that fact.
13. Please follow instructions given to you by horse park stewards and all other stewards.
14. Vehicles are limited to 5mph on site.

Class 1 BEST TURNED OUT

Neatest and cleanest-riders 14 and under on 1/1/10, pony of suitable height for rider.

Class 2 LEAD REIN PONY

Open to Show Ponies, Show Hunter Ponies & M&M ponies. Riders 9 and under on 1/1/10. This class is to find the most suitable & well-mannered Lead Rein pony. All competitors receive a prize. **Snaffle Bridle only, lead rein to be attached to the noseband.**

Class 3 FIRST RIDDEN PONY

Open to Show Ponies, Show Hunter Ponies & M&M ponies. Riders 10 and under on 1/1/10. This class is to find the most suitable and well-mannered First Ridden Pony. All competitors receive a prize. **Snaffle Bridle only.**

Class 4 LEAD REIN EQUITATION

Riders 9 and under on 1/1/10. All competing receive a rosette. **Snaffle Bridle only, lead rein to be attached to the noseband.**

Class 5 FIRST RIDDEN EQUITATION

Rider 10 years and under on 1/1/10. Ponies will not be cantered together. They may canter if they choose in their individual shows. All competing receive a prize.

Class 6 JUNIOR EQUITATION

Riders age 11-14 on 1/1/10.

Class 7 BONNY PONY

Ridden or in hand. All junior competitors must wear an approved riding hat when showing in hand. All competitors receive a rosette. Riders/handlers 14 and under on 1/1/10

Class 8 BONNY PONY THELWELL TYPE

Ridden or in hand. All junior competitors must wear an approved riding hat when showing in hand. All competitors receive a prize. Riders/handlers 14 and under on 1/1/10

Class 9 BEST TAIL

All competitors receive a rosette. Riders/handlers 14 and under on 1/1/10

Class 10 YOUNG HANDLER

Handler 14 years and under on 1/1/10. All handlers must wear a correctly fitting and fastened riding hat.

Class 11 BEST CONDITIONED PONY

not exceeding 148cms/14.2h.h. Handler 14 years and under on 1/1/10.

Class 12 LEAD REIN RIDING CLUB PONY

Competitors 9 years and under on 1/1/10. Competitors will incorporate a small fence into their individual show.
